WAO 2026 team selection process

- Handlers must comply with WAO rules to be able to compete for Israel.
- Preference will be given to dogs in A2-A3 level for the team competition.
- All expenses for the WAO will be paid by the handler.
- Handler is responsible for the transport of their dog to and from WAO competition.
- Competitors may be required to attend seminars and/or training days at an additional cost.
- Handlers under 18 years old must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- At the time of team selection, handlers must be a citizen of the country they represent, or have a birth certificate from that country, have parents or grandparents born in that country or have permanent resident status.

All registration requests must be received by 28/2/26 at midnight (Israelis time). If there are more than three dogs in a specific height category the top place dog in the competition on 6/3/26 (Kfar Truman) will automatically represent Israel in the Biathlon and Pentathlon. The remaining places will be selected at the discretion of the team manager.
