



To: Kazakhstan Handlers

This is a notification directed to any Kazakhstan Dog Agility Handlers interested in participating in the World Agility Open Championships 2026 in Ermelo, Netherlands on the 13th – 17th May.

To apply to the 2026 team, you must be a citizen of Kazakhstan, or have a birth certificate from that country, have parents or grandparents born in that country or have permanent resident status.

The handler will pay all expenses for the WAO, including travel expenses, hotels, entry fees etc. Competitors may be required to attend seminars and/or training days at an additional cost. A parent or legal guardian must accompany handlers under 18 years old.

The handler must independently prepare all veterinary documents; including ensuring the dog has a rabies vaccination and a certificate of rabies antibodies obtained more than 90 days before the intended travel date.

Minimum requirements for a dog to be included in the Kazakhstan team: the dog must have at least one excellent rating and a clean run in a class no lower than A2 at any agility competition held between August 1, 2025, and January 30, 2026.

All registrations requests must be received by February 15st 2026 at midnight (Kazakhstan time). If there are more than three dogs in a specific height category, the top-placed dog in the agility competition, scheduled for November 4, 2025 , in Almaty at the 'LOCOMOTIVE' venue, will automatically represent Kazakhstan in the Biathlon and Pentathlon. The remaining places will be selected at the discretion of the team manager.
