



WAO2020 Singapore Team Selection

Thank you for your interest in participating as part of the Singapore Team to the 2020 World Agility Open in Ermelo, The Netherlands (15th – 17th May 2020).

To apply for the team, you must be a Singapore citizen or Permanent Resident of Singapore.

Please note that the trip is self-funded i.e. you will need to pay for all expenses related to the trip including, but not limited to, travel, vet and quarantine expenses, as well as WAO entry fees, team jackets and t-shirts, etc.

Singapore agility handlers wanting to compete at WAO2020 should write-in to singaporeuki@gmail.com to let your country manager know of your interest.

Selection for the Singapore team will be based on points accumulated from the best of 4 (four) UKI trials organized by Clean Run Agility Club and/or Go For Flow, up until the end of October 2019. *If there are more than three teams applying to compete in any one WAO height class, then the top three teams (based on highest points accumulated) will be offered spots in that height class.*

In the event of a tie, then the final UKI show of 2019, organized by Clean Run Agility Club, on December 8th will be used as a tie-breaker.

The table below shows the qualification points allotted to placings for UKI Masters Heats and Senior / Champion level runs under the UKI International Program.

***NOTE:**

- 1) An additional 2 points will be awarded for placings with clean runs
- 2) No points are awarded for Elimination
- 3) No points are awarded for runs in Novice / Beginner Classes
- 4) No points are awarded for Speedstakes

3. Details and points accumulated from your 4 best UKI trials until end-Oct 2019 i.e. show organizer (CRAC or GFF), trial dates & your ranking
4. Which of the following WAO2020 event(s) you want to take part in:
 - Pentathlon Championship: 2 rounds of Agility, 2 rounds Jumping, and 1 round Speedstakes
 - Biathlon Championship: 1 round Agility and 1 round Jumping
 - Games Championship: Snooker and Gamblers
 - Team Championship: 2 rounds Agility, 2 rounds Jumping and a Team Relay

A non-refundable deposit of S\$400 must be made to the Singapore team management by 30 November 2019. This money will be used for partial payment of Team Entry Fees, stables, team t-shirts, etc. The amount and deadline may be subject to change.

In the event spots are not taken, the country manager reserves the right to fill that spot at his/her own discretion, which may include inviting Singapore citizens based overseas (and are hence unable to compete in the UKI Singapore trials) to fill the spot.
