Team Switzerland 2020

This is a notification directed to any Swiss Dog Agility handler interested in participating in the World Agility Open Championships 2020 in the Netherlands. Any handler who wishes to join the 2020 team, must be a Swiss citizen or a resident of Switzerland.

For each height category, a maximum of three dogs are permitted (exceptions can be discussed, e.g. if a handler runs with two dogs). As team coach, Bettina Stemmler (300) will be entered to compete for Switzerland.

Selected will be furthermore the dogs with the most points accumulated in the competitions listed below. If there are not enough dogs per height with points, the country manager will select the dogs on a first come, first served basis.

Swiss Agility Championships 2018 and/or 2019 (20 points for 1st place through to 1 point for 20th)

- Qualification Agility
- Qualification Jumping
- Final Agility
- Final Jumping
- Combined ranking list

At the moment it seems that there will be no Swiss Agility Championships 2019 – if there is none, the final ranking list of the qualification for the European Open 2019 will count instead (20 points for 1st place through to 1 point for 20th).

WAO 2018 and/or 2019 (20 points for 1st place through to 1 point for 20th)

- Games: Gambler
- Games: Snooker
- Games: combined ranking list
- Biathlon: Jumping
- Biathlon: Agility
- Biathlon: combined ranking list
- Pentathlon: combined ranking list after 4
- Pentathlon: combined ranking list after 5
- Pentathlon: Speedstakes Final
- Bonus Speedstakes

WAO Junior World Championships

In addition one junior handler (also Swiss Citizen or resident of Switzerland, date of birth must be on or after 16th May 2001) in each height category is invited to compete for the WAO Junior World Champion. Juniors must be under 19 on the Friday of the WAO competition weekend 2020. The junior with the most accumulated points in the competitions listed above will be selected. If there are only entries without points, the country manager will select the dog/handler junior team.
